## Professorship of Public Law, especially Administrative Law (grade W3, Chair with tenure as a civil servant)

to be appointed as soon as possible.

Applicants shall cover Public Law and, in particular, Administrative Law in its entire breadth, both in their research activities and in teaching. A focus on specific areas of Administrative Law is welcome, especially in Building and Planning Law or in Environmental Law. The Faculty is renowned throughout Germany for its intradisciplinary focus area 3 "Real Estate Law". Three of its chairs and an honorary professorship are affiliated with the interdisciplinary Institute of Real Estate Economics (IREBS) of the University of Regensburg, Europe's largest centre for real estate business, with manifold research and teaching activities in this area. The successful applicant is expected to offer courses in focus area 3. Furthermore, they are expected to contribute to further sharpen the research profile of the Faculty and the University in this subject area. Readiness for interdisciplinary cooperation and to participate in third-party funded projects is required for that. An additional specialization in Environmental Law would be desirable with a view to widening the research profile of University.

Alongside the general requirements of public sector employment law, prerequisites for taking up the position are a completed university degree, pedagogic suitability, a particular aptitude for academic work, shown by the quality of the doctoral dissertation, as well as additional academic achievements. These can be demonstrated by a habilitation or equivalent academic work, which may also have been completed outside the university sector or within the framework of a junior professorship.

Universität Regensburg is particularly committed to reconciling family and working life (for more information, see www.uni-regensburg.de/familienservice). In order to fulfil the equality directive and increase the number of female professors, we explicitly encourage applications from qualified women.

In case of essentially similar suitability, applicants with severe disabilities will be preferentially selected.

The prerequisites for appointment under civil service law are based on the provisions of the Bavarian Public Service Code (BayBG) and the Bavarian University Staff Act (BayHSchPG).
